

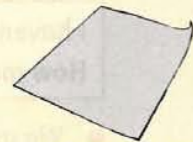
6 a bar of chocolate, a loaf of bread

- We cannot count uncountable nouns, but we can count:
 - the litres, grams or kilos: *a litre of milk* *a kilo of meat*
 - the containers: *a cup of tea* *three bottles of water*
 - the pieces: *a piece of chocolate* *two slices of bread*
 - the things we buy: *a bar of chocolate* *a loaf of bread*
- We can also use *a piece of* with some other nouns: *a piece of advice*, *a piece of furniture*, *a piece of luggage*, *a piece of music*, *a piece of paper*
